ASSOCIATE/FULL PROFESSOR OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY**

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** The Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders in the College of Allied Health at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center announces the availability of a full-time, tenure-track position in Speech-Language Pathology at the level of Associate or Full Professor. The major responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to, the following:

- conducting research in areas of interest, directing student research, and serving on/chairing doctoral dissertation committees.
- maintaining federal research grants.
- teaching a limited number of courses in the Ph.D. program in Speech-Language Pathology.
- participating in department, college, and university governance.

**Required Qualifications:** Earned Ph.D. degree, demonstration of an established line of funded research in speech-language pathology and/or related disciplines, current federal funding as a Principal Investigator, and evidence of a sustained record of successful university teaching, research, service, and extramural funding.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Ability to interface with departmental research initiatives and aspects of the OUHSC's campus-wide strategic research mission.
