

*Tic-Toc training is a series of regional skill-building workshops designed to assist child care providers to feel competent about including children with disabilities in typical child care settings.*

**Fall Series Workshop Descriptions:**

- ◆ **Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 (IDEA)** This workshop focuses on the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 and how child care staff can incorporate strategies to support children receiving services under IDEA.
- ◆ **Working with Children with Disabilities Who Have Challenging Behaviors I** This workshop focuses on working with children who have challenging behaviors. Areas to be discussed include: assessment of the environment, determining key issues which influence the child's behavior, and intervention strategies.
- ◆ **Including Children with Disabilities in Child Care Settings** This workshop focuses on basic information for child care staff about how to work with children with disabilities and their families, including understanding common disabilities, how to plan for a child with a disability, and statewide and community resources.
- ◆ **Development Across Domains: Typical/Atypical Child Development (OKC ONLY)** This workshop focuses on the areas of cognitive, communication, self-help, motor, and social-emotional development and the impact a disability may have on typical development in these areas.
- ◆ **Communicating with Families & Community Resources (TULSA ONLY)** This workshop focuses on the importance of effective communication with the families of children with disabilities and the community. Areas to be discussed include: effective conflict resolution, program referral, follow-up, and reporting systems. We will spend time understanding our roles in the larger community and how to navigate community systems for successful inclusion.

TIC-TOC training will count toward the CDA credential and is approved for Tier II contact hours by CECPD.
