

Tic-Toc training is a series of regional skill-building trainings designed to assist child care providers to feel competent about including children with disabilities in typical child care settings.

Fall 2009 Series Training Descriptions:

- ◆ **Infant Toddlers Curriculum Planning & Intervention** The most we can do for young children is prevent delays and atypical development. This training focuses on screening, individual program planning, and early intervention for infants and toddlers.
- ◆ **Deciphering the Disability Code** This training focuses on the language of disabilities and the specific lingo used in service plans. Participants will gain a greater understanding of the wording associated with childhood disabilities along with breakdowns of a broad spectrum of these disorders. Time will be spent learning the basic language to help expand your general disability knowledge.
- ◆ **Supporting Children with Autism in Inclusive Childcare Settings** This course will include information on recognized characteristics of autism spectrum disorders (ASD), techniques for supporting children with ASD, and the importance of inclusive childcare settings for children with ASD and their families.
- ◆ **Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 (IDEA) (OKC AND TULSA ONLY)** This training focuses on the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 and how child care staff can incorporate strategies to support children receiving services under IDEA.
