

Sample Plan of Study for Students with a Bachelor's Degree in Occupational Therapy or Physical Therapy

The following sample plan of study is for students with a bachelor's degree in occupational therapy or physical therapy and no postprofessional degree. The plan is an example that indicates the semesters that OUHSC courses are offered and a recommended sequence of courses. Some flexibility in coursework and timing of courses is possible and students need to work with their advisors and committees to develop their individualized plans of study.

Two sample plans are shown. One is for students who wish to take 18 credits per year and complete the program in four years. The other is for students who are able to take more credits per year and complete the program in three years. Courses with an asterisk (*) do not need to be taken the semesters indicated. They can be taken any time agreeable to the faculty and student. Outside area courses (cognate) and statistics also can be taken at any time. RS 5990 Special Studies is intended for students to work with faculty on research-related projects.

Students are responsible for working with their advisors to ensure their plans of study include the courses and [credits required for graduation](#). Scheduling of courses may change at any time.
