

Sample Plan of Study for Students with a Professional MOT, MPT, DPT, or Similar Degree

The following sample plan of study is for students with post-baccalaureate professional degrees, such as master of occupational therapy, master of physical therapy, and doctor of physical therapy. The plan is an example that indicates the semesters that OUHSC courses are offered and a recommended sequence of courses. Some flexibility in coursework and timing of courses is possible and students need to work with their advisors and committees to develop their individualized plans of study.

The plan includes more than the required number of credits to show possible courses each semester. Courses with an asterisk (*) do not need to be taken the semesters indicated. They can be taken any time agreeable to the faculty and student. Outside area courses (cognate) and statistics also can be taken at any time.

Students are responsible for working with their advisors to ensure their plans of study include the courses and [credits required for graduation](#). Scheduling of courses may change at any time.
