

## Sample Plan of Study for Students with An OUHSC Master of Science Degree in Rehabilitation Sciences

The following sample plan of study is for students with a master of science degree in rehabilitation sciences with a pediatric emphasis from the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center (OUHSC). Students with postprofessional degrees from other institutions should contact the program to determine requirements.

The plan is an example that indicates the semesters that OUHSC courses are offered and a recommended sequence of courses. Some flexibility in coursework and timing of courses is possible and students need to work with their advisors and committees to develop their individualized plans of study.

Courses with an asterisk (\*) do not need to be taken the semesters indicated. They can be taken any time agreeable to the faculty and student. Outside area courses (cognate) and statistics also can be taken at any time. RS 5990 Special Studies is intended for students to work with faculty on research-related projects.

Students are responsible for working with their advisors to ensure their plans of study include the courses and [credits required for graduation](#). Scheduling of courses may change at any time.
